



## **Vision Statement**

Newbridge School provides a specialist education for 68 students in Key Stages 3 and 4 who have been Permanently Excluded.

We believe in a person-centred approach that helps our young people to get their education back on track after their recent setbacks. We give our students a fresh start through a person-centred review. This process helps us to work with families and carers to identify an individual approach to each student's time at Newbridge.

Each student can expect to progress with their English and maths whilst at Newbridge. Young people here will also be supported to develop to develop reading skills and aspects of their personal and social education, including careers. Students will also be offered other GCSEs and various non-GCSE qualifications including those offered by NCFE.

We recognise that many of our students have encountered significant barriers to learning in the past. We believe that these barriers are best overcome through positive engagement with our students and good mental health. This is the reason why our curriculum is becoming more focussed on off-site learning and therapeutic activities.

We strive daily so that our students here at Newbridge feel valued and cared for in order that they can achieve to their full potential.
